****Appreciative Inquiry**

Appreciative Inquiry (AI) is a positive, resource oriented organizational process that explores, builds on, and expands the inherent life giving qualities of any individual or human system. The AI approach contrasts many contemporary organizational interventions that utilize an illness model to focus on and eliminate problems. These approaches when applied to human systems often result in blame and defensiveness, which enfeebles rather than inspires people to do better. Beyond being an organizational process, appreciative inquiry becomes a generative way of being in the world that energizes and enables the creative best in people and their organizations.

Training Objectives

In this 2.5 day (15 CEU) AI training you will:

- Gain an in-depth understanding of Appreciative Inquiry.
- Conduct an appreciative inquiry into your own vocation.
- Review and develop your own personal mission.
- Learn appreciative ways of managing change.
- Learn how to be an appreciative presence in the world.

***Facilitator, Dr. Rob Voyle**, is an ordained Episcopal Priest, executive coach, and church consultant.
