- > Support for the New Westminster Food Bank, the largest depot in the Lower Mainland serving over 500 individuals a week (representing over 1100 people)
- > The HP Drop-in on food bank days
- > Resource information and referral
- > An Advocate to assist with critical issues
- > Courtesy telephone
- > Clothing and household goods
- > A children's and family's drop-in run by NW Family Place
- > High school teacher provided by the NW School District
- > Community services such as health and nutrition
- > Support for 12-Step recovery groups
