HOW TO JOIN:

Signing up is a breeze. Just click on <http://unitedcamping.ning.com/main/authorization/signUp> and you'll be taken to the network's sign-up page.

1. First, type in your email address. You'll enter this email address every time you sign in to the social network, and all notifications will arrive in this email's inbox.
2. Next, enter a password. If this is the first time signing up for a social network on Ning, this is your chance to create a password. Otherwise, just enter the password you've already created.
3. Retype your password to confirm that you've entered it correctly.
4. Use the drop-down menus to enter your date of birth.

The Ning Platform is not directed to children younger than 13 and is offered only to users 13 years of age or older. If you are under 13 years old, please do not use the Ning Platform. Any person who provides their personal information through the Ning Platform represents to us that they are 13 years of age or older. Your birthdate will not appear anywhere you don't want it to (see 'My Page' once you've joined).

5. Type in the text exactly as you see it in the image on the right (called a CAPTCHA). This step ensures that you're a real person!
6. Click the "Sign Up" button to join the social network! By signing up, you agree to the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, which you can read by clicking on the links to them.
7. You should receive a pop-up stating that your membership has to be approved before you can join. However, you can view the main page of the network right away. Approvals will be done by the Administrator and should not take more than one day to approve (hopefully less).
